- This will be on the basis of the following matrix:

- All participants are expected to refrain from using unfair means while participating in their respective events.
- The decision of the judges and referees will be final and binding.
- Violation of the rules and regulations of the fest will result in a penalty and may lead to disqualification from the event or the fest.
